Chris McDonald from Oak Avenue is 17 years old and has been an apprentice joiner for Bellway since September 2005.

After he left school he wasn't sure what he wanted to do, but then he heard about the apprenticeship scheme with Bellway and sent in his CV. He was thrilled when he found out that he had been successful, because at first he wasn't sure which trade he wanted to learn. In the end, he decided on joinery as he had been interested in that subject at school and he felt that there would be a lot more variety in this line of work.

Chris said "I enjoy doing this job. I know after my 3 year apprenticeship I will have a trade, it is a qualification that will help me secure my future. I would recommend it to anyone who wants to get into the construction trade". Chris attends college as part of his apprenticeship on a block release basis, attending in blocks of 2-3 weeks at a time.
